Introduce yourself to the mediums and techniques of painting. Students will learn basic and introductory methods of painting, working in watercolors, acrylics, inks, and other materials to create beautiful works of art.



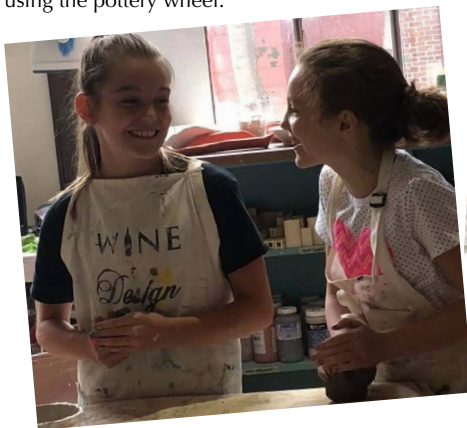
Drawing

Explore the mediums and techniques of drawing in black and white. Students will use pencil, pen, charcoal, ink, Pastel and other materials to create advanced works of art.



Clay

Create works of art from clay using hand-building and wheel-throwing. Explore the introductory methods of hand-building clay including pinch, coil, and slab techniques. Students will also learn and create ceramic vessels using the pottery wheel.
